NCC Establishment – Disciplinary action on Misappropriation of non Public funds
by Sri.VD.Stephen, HC, NCC Dte,TVPM- Finalised –Orders issued

ORDER

1. A case of misappropriation of non public fund amounting to Rs 35924/- held by 1(K)Arty Bty NCC was reported by OC,1(K)Arty Bty NCC,Thalassery vide reference cited 2nd above against Sri Stephen VD, Head Clerk,1(K)Arty Bty NCC who was holding the DDO charge of that unit. In pursuance of the said report, an audit was conducted and based on the audit report, a prima facie case against Sri Stephen VD, Head Clerk,1(K)Arty Bty NCC was established and he was suspended from service wef 21/5/2018 vide this Dte proceedings cited 3rd above pending disciplinary proceedings.

2. Subsequently an enquiry was conducted and MOC issued to Sri Stephen VD. In the reply he agreed the charge and he refunded the entire amount of Rs. 35924/- to non public(units regimental fund). As the period of suspension of six months expired he was reinstated as HC in this Dte wef 20/11/18 vide this Dte proceedings 4th above as per Rule 10(a) of KCS(CCA)Rules 1960

3. Now as per instructions contained in Circular cited 1st above this Directorate has decided to proceed with finalisation of disciplinary proceedings against Sri.VD Stephen, HC for the proved charges against him regarding misappropriation of Rs. 35924/- to non public(unit regimental fund). The proposal for awarding punishment has been intimated to the incumbent vide letter read as 5th paper and reply to the same has been received vide letter referred as 6th paper above.

4. In the circumstances, the following punishments are ordered against Sri.VD Stephen, HC as per Kerala Civil Services (CC&A) Rules 1960:-

- (a) Withholding of promotion to the post of Junior Superintendent for eight months from the due date of promotion to next vacancy arise after eight months as per seniority list. [Rule 11 (1) (iii)]. KCS(CCA)Rules 1960.
- (b) The suspension period of 180 days will be regularised against his eligible leave of commuted leave and balance from earned leave on credit as per his representation dated 07/01/19 in accordance with Rule 56(B) and (7) of KSR Part 1.
- (c) The above action will not have any effect on his pensionary benefits.
6. Necessary entries should be made in the service book of the individual under proper attestation. The Disciplinary proceedings against Sri.Stephen VD, HC, NCC Directorate is finalised accordingly.
